Revises the specific criteria for granting temporary protection to persons displaced from Ukraine.

Under paragraph 3 of Article 4 of Law No. 67/2003 of 23 August, and point (g) of Article 199 of the Constitution, the Council of Ministers resolves:

1 — To amend Resolution of the Council of Ministers No. 29-A/2022 of 1 March, in its current wording, which shall now read as follows: "1 — [...]"

2 — To determine that the following shall also benefit from this temporary protection:

a) foreign citizens of other nationalities who prove that they are family members of the persons referred to in the preceding paragraph or that they are permanent residents of Ukraine and whose safe and durable return to their country of nationality is not possible;

b) stateless persons who prove that they are family members of the persons referred to in the preceding paragraph or that they are permanent residents of Ukraine.

3 — To establish that, for the purposes of the preceding paragraph, the following are considered family members:

a) spouses;

b) persons who have lived with a person referred to in paragraph 1 in conditions comparable to those of spouses for more than two years;

c) the minor children of a person referred to in paragraph 1 or of his or her spouse or de facto partner, including those who are adopted;

d) other close relatives who live in the same household and who are wholly or largely dependent on a person referred to in paragraph 1.

10 — To establish that the communications referred to in paragraphs 8 and 9 are made, preferably, by electronic data transmission, in compliance with the general data-protection
