

Resolução do Conselho de Ministros n.º 29/2024, de 29 de fevereiro

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Extends the validity of the temporary protection titles granted to persons displaced from Ukraine.

Under Article 7 of Law No. 67/2003 of 23 August, in its current wording, and point (g) of Article 199 of the Constitution, the Council of Ministers resolves:

- 1 — To amend paragraphs 6 and 8 of Resolution of the Council of Ministers No. 29-A/2022 of 1 March, as amended by Resolutions No. 29-D/2022 of 11 March, No. 135/2022 of 28 December and No. 22-D/2023 of 13 March, as follows: "6 — To determine that, for the purposes of the preceding paragraph, the Agency for Integration, Migration and Asylum (AIMA, I.P.) carries out the consultation of the Schengen Information System and other relevant databases, through the competent entities, a criminal-record certificate not being required.
- 8 — To determine that the declaration confirming the application for temporary protection is communicated by AIMA, I.P., to the social security service, the Tax and Customs Authority and the Shared Services of the Ministry of Health, E.P.E., for the automatic allocation of the social-security identification number, the tax identification number and the national user number, respectively."
- 2 — To extend the validity of the temporary protection titles granted under Resolution of the Council of Ministers No. 29-A/2022 of 1 March, in its current wording, until 31 December 2024.
- 3 — To establish that this resolution takes effect on 1 March 2024. Presidency of the Council of Ministers, 22 February 2024. — The Prime Minister, Antonio Luis Santos da Costa.
