

Resolução do Conselho de Ministros n.º 29-D/2022, de 11 de março

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Broadens the scope of temporary protection granted to persons displaced from Ukraine.

Under paragraph 3 of Article 4 of Law No. 67/2003 of 23 August, and point (g) of Article 199 of the Constitution, the Council of Ministers resolves:

1 — To amend Resolution of the Council of Ministers No. 29-A/2022 of 1 March, with the following wording: "1 — To grant temporary protection, with the automatic issuance of a residence permit, for a period of one year, with the possibility of extending the respective residence title, under Article 7 of Law No. 67/2003 of 23 August, to Ukrainian nationals and to foreign citizens of other nationalities or stateless persons who benefited from international protection in Ukraine, coming from that country and unable to return there as a consequence of the war taking place there.

2 — To determine that foreign citizens of other nationalities or stateless persons who are in the circumstances of the preceding paragraph and prove that they are family members of the persons referred to, or that they are permanent residents of Ukraine, or hold a temporary residence permit, or benefit from a long-term visa for obtaining such a permit, and whose safe and durable return to their country of origin is not possible, shall also benefit from this temporary protection.

15 — To determine the establishment of the inter-ministerial commission provided for in Article 5 of Law No. 67/2003 of 23 August, jointly chaired by the members of the Government responsible for integration and migration and for internal administration, and composed of representatives of the governmental areas of economy and digital transition, foreign affairs, justice, and labour, solidarity and social security; representatives of other governmental areas may also take part in the commission's meetings, depending on the subject, at the invitation of the presiding members of the Government.
